Kyoto Paradise is a small book art gallery located in the vicinity of Kyoto Municipal Art museum, Modern Art museum and the famous Nanzenji temple area. Gallery has hosted book art and print exhibitions regularly since 2002. Mokuhanga ehon exhibition is a joint event to International Mokuhanga Conference IMC2021 in Nara. We are following closely the possible changes in the corona regulations. The exhibition date will be confirmed by the end of July, 2021

Application time: August 1 – 31, 2021. **Acceptance announcement:** September 15-17, 2021.

Exhibition is juried by professional book artists. Decisions with detailed instructions will be sent by email.

Conditions: Both oil-based and waterbased woodblock print books are eligible, also works made with mixed method. Only handmade books are accepted. Books that offend political or religious sensitivity will be excluded. Materials that smudge hands will also be excluded.

Number of entries: 1 book or a set of books (e.g. part 1, part 2 bound together) per artist. Small works are preferred. Total dimension of the book (height+width+thickness) should not exceed 70 cm.

Participation fee: 5000 JPY (45 €/45 USD). Fee is to be paid via PayPal, or in cash at the gallery.

Gallery commission: 25% from the sold items. **Insurance:** The gallery will not take responsibility for any damages, loss or theft that may occur to artworks while they are being displayed or during transportation. Artists are asked to provide their own insurances before sending in their work.

Copyrights: Artists give permission to use images of their artworks on the gallery web page, social media and advertisements.
